The medical equipment worth RM49,790 consist of 7 units of Top-5530RS syringe pump with pole clamp and 1 unit of David HKN-93 radiant warmer. These medical equipment are crucial for various purposes such as precise fluid delivery and optimal thermal support for newborns in critical care.

HSIS, formerly known as Hospital Serdang, was established in May 2005. It is a government hospital that operates with the Total Hospital Information System. As a referral hospital with 1063 beds, it is equipped with state-of-the-art facilities and provides both Specialist Secondary Unit and Tertiary Levels of Care.

Over the years, RCE has been focusing on promoting health awareness through various medical equipment donations. To-date, RCE donated close to RM780,000 worth of medical equipment to 7 government hospitals: Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah, Hospital Sungai Buloh, Hospital Ampang, Hospital Kuala Lumpur, Hospital Putrajaya, Hospital Umum Sarawak, and HSIS.
